Chains



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of corner.

Land, mountainous. Soil; gravelly shallow clay loam; heavy barren outcrops, granite rock, altered. Undergrowth; Sage brush and bunch grass. Timber; scattering growth of junipers.

East on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Ascend W. slope.

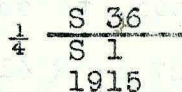
12.44 Top of a ridge, 100 ft. above corner, bears N. and S.

Descend E. slope.

27.70 Canyon, wash in bottom, 8 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, 160 ft. below ridge, course N.

Ascend W. slope of ridge.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high N. of cor. This cor. is 360 ft. above canyon.

41.62 Top of spur, 18 ft. above corner, bears N. 20°W. and S. 20°E.

Descend along N. slope.

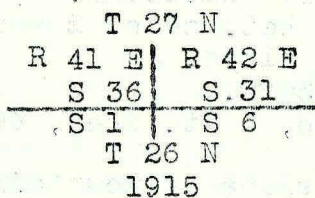
Ascend.

68.00 Top of spur, 175 ft. above draw, bears N. and S.

Descend E. slope of spur.

73.50 Gulch, 8 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, 125 ft. below spur, course N. 1 ch. thence N. 70°E.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 N., Rgs. 41 and 42 E., with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high S. of corner.

Land; broken rough mountains. Soil; shallow, rocky and gravelly clay loam. Barren outcrops of altered granite rock. Undergrowth, sage brush and light growth of grass. Timber; scattered growth of junipers.

June 18, 1915: At 8h 00m apparent time, I set off 23° 25'N. on the decl. arc and 40° 09'N. on the lat. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. to Tps. 26 and 27 N., Rgs. 41 and 42 E.

Thence I run

N. on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

1.50 Ravine, course E.

Ascend S.E. slope of spur.
