

Resurvey of E. bdy. of T. 27 N., R. 43 E.

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of corner.

Land, slightly rolling drains W. Soil, deep alluvial and washed accumulative sandy light brown clay loam, medium texture, loose and imbedded round boulders from foothills on surface.

Undergrowth; sagebrush, white sage, shadscale, browse and bunch grass.

No timber.

Not on meridian at noon on this date, to make an observation for latitude.

From the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, I run N. $0^{\circ} 08' E.$, on a true line on the E. bdy. of sec. 12, course and distance by previous retracement.

Over slightly rolling land, gradual ascent.

19.13 Top of low ridge, bears N. $40^{\circ} E.$ and S. $40^{\circ} W.$; gradual descent.

40.20 Dry wash, course N. $70^{\circ} W.$.

40.33 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 7 and 12, hereafter a $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 12 only. I remonument the corner with an iron post as follows:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, alongside the old corner, with brass cap mkd.,

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of corner.

I now change the bearing and run N. $0^{\circ} 22' E.$, course and distance by previous retracement.

Gradual ascent 60 ft. to the corner.

77.00 Gradual ascent along S. W. slope.

80.65 The old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, heretofore described and hereafter referring to the cor. of secs. 1 and 12 of T. 27 N., R. 43 E. only. I remonument the cor. with an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, alongside the old cor., with brass cap mkd.,

From the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, I run N. $0^{\circ} 14' E.$ on a true line on the E. bdy. of sec. 1, course and distance by previous retracement.

Over rolling W. slope of ridge, bearing N. and S.;
