Land, mountainous, ascend S. W. slope and along W. slope of high mountain. Soil, rocky and shallow light brown clay loam, medium texture loose and imbedded granite rock on surface, exposed granite ledges. Undergrowth; sagebrush and scant growth bunch grass. No timber.

SOUTH BOUNDARY T. 27 N., R. 44 EAST

May 26, 1915: For solar on this date see survey of line bet. secs. 31 and 36 on E. bdy.

The cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 N., R. 44 and 45 E., was established at the intersection of a line produced S. from the cor. of Tps. 27 and 28 N., Rs. 44 and 45 E., with a line produced E. from the cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 N., Rs. 43 and 44 E., therefore from this cor. previously described I run,

West on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over mountainous land, ascend steep rocky slope.

15.25 Top of dividing ridge between Reese River valley on W. and Crescent Valley on E., 495 ft. above Tp. corner, bears N. and S., soon turns S.E. descend rocky E. slope 555 ft. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of corner.

Descend gradual W. slope 305 ft. to the corner.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.,

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of corner.

Land, mountainous, ascend and crossing main divide and descend W. slope of same.

Soil; rocky and gravelly clay loam, shallow with several exposed ledges of granite and porphyry. Undergrowth; sagebrush and bunch grass. No timber.

West on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Over rolling mountainous land, descend.

7.20 Bottom of ravine, 125 ft. below corner course N $^{\circ}$ 40 $^{\circ}$ W. ascend along N. slope.

24.23 Top of spur, projects N $^{\circ}$ 40 $^{\circ}$ W., 155 ft. above ravine descend.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,
