	Surveyed by H.W. Reppert. May 26, 1915: For solar on this date see line bet. secs. 31 and 36 on E. bdy. From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. I run, N. 0° 01' W. bet. secs. 35 and 36. Over rolling W. slope of mountains, ascend gradually along W. slope. 7.00 Bottom of draw, 10 ft. below cor., course W.; ascend. 21.66 Top of spur, 140 ft. above draw, bears S. 60° W. and N. 60° E.; descend. 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd., S35 $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 1915 and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of corner. 45.00 Cross deep gulch, 175 ft. below top of spur, course W.; ascend. 47.08 Summit of spur, 25 ft. above gulch, projects W.; descend. 57.00 Bottom of draw, 40 ft. below top of spur, ascend. 67.22 Top of ascent 40 ft. above draw; descend 65 ft. to the sec. cor. 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd., T27NR44E S26 S25 S35 S36 1915 and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of corner. Land, rolling W. slope of mountains. Soil; deep moist loose light brown clay loam, loose and imbedded boulders on surface, some exposed outcrops on ridges and spurs. Undergrowth; sagebrush, some service berry and good growth bunch grass. No timber. Clouds obscure the sun on this date and I am unable to make an observation for latitude.
40.00	East on a random line bet. secs. 25 and 36
80.06	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Intersect E. bdy. of the Tp. at the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36. Thence I run West on a true line bet. secs. 25 and 36 Over mountainous land, ascend. 15.30 Summit of the main dividing range, 480 ft. above corner, bears N. and S.; descend W. slope, 605 ft. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. 40.03 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd., S25 $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 1915 and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of corner. Descend W. slope of mountain 520 ft. to the sec. cor. 80.06 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36. Land; mountainous, ascend and crossing main divide. Soil; rocky light brown clay loam, exposed ledges on ridges and spurs. Undergrowth; sagebrush, service berry
