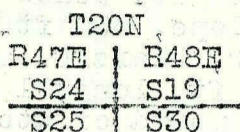

Chains

the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, with brass cap mkd.,

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of corner.

Land, mountainous and rolling foothills, broken and rough.

Soil, loose clay loam with abundance of loose rock and some exposed ledges.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunch grass.

No timber.

At this cor. I set off 19° 21' N. on the decl. arc; and about 12h. 06m., p.m., 1.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 39° 35' N.

South on a true line bet. secs. 25 and 30

Over rolling foothills; descend.

12.90 Bottom of dry wash 70 ft. below cor., course S. 75° E.; ascend.

18.30 Top of small ridge, 30 ft. above wash, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.; descend 60 ft. to the ¼ sec. cor.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

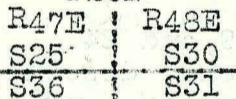
and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of corner.

Descend gradual slope.

75.00 Enter valley land 80 ft. below ¼ sec. cor.; thence over nearly level valley land.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd.,

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of corner.

Land, descend from mountains into foothills and valley.

Soil, sandy clay loam fairly free from rock.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbit brush and bunch grass.

No timber.

South bet. secs. 31 and 36

Over nearly level valley land, slopes gently southward.

3.00 Road from Ackerman canyon to Eureka, bears E. and W.

14.60 Dry wash, 20 lks. wide, course S. 85° E.

14.70 Gradually ascend.

25.00 Top of ridge, 10 ft. above cr., bears S. 80° E. and N. 80° W.; gradually descend.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,
