

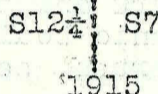

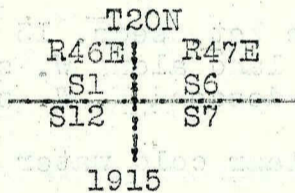
Chains

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of cor.
 Land, rough mountains, descend along spur into canyon and along steep S.W. slope.
 Soil, deep rich dark loam in ravines and canyon, very shallow and rocky on ridges, slide rock on N. 20 chs., some exposed outcrops.
 Undergrowth, sagebrush, service berry, good growth bunch grass, willows along dry bed of creek in canyon.
 Timber, aspen along canyon, otherwise no timber.

N. on a true line bet. secs. 7 and 12.
 Over mountainous land, ascend along steep S. W. slope rocky.
 18.36 Top of slope 260 ft. above sec. cor., descend N.W. slope.
 24.63 Ravine, 155 ft. below top of slope, course N. 70°W.; ascend 120 ft. to the ¼ sec. cor.
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of corner.
 Descend N. W. slope.
 43.30 Gulch, 10 ft. below ¼ sec. cor., course S. 80°W., ascend.
 54.93 Top of high ridge, 70 ft. above gulch, bears S. 75°W. and N. 75°E.; descend N. slope thru scattering pine timber, 305 ft. to the cor.
 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of corner; from which
 A Pinon Pine 10 ins. diam., bears N. 13° 30'E., 250 lks. dist. mkd. T20NR47ES6BT
 A Pinon Pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 14°W., 315 lks. dist., mkd. T20NR46ES1BT
 No other large trees near for marking.
 Land, high mountainous crossing high ridge and descend steep N. slope.
 Soil, shallow dark loam, very rocky, loose and imbedded granite rock and several outcrops of same.
 Undergrowth, scattering growth pinon pine and mountain mahogany on N. ½ mile.
 At this cor. I set off 14° 50'N. on the decl. arc; and about 12h. 05m. p.m., l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 39° 38'N.

N. on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 6.
 Over mountainous land, descend steep, N. slope thru dense pine and mahogany timber.
 33.22 Top of spur, projects W., continue descent.
 39.00 Ravine, 695 ft. below cor., 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 60°E.; descend along N.E. slope 510 ft. to the closing corner.
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in
