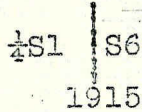


Subdivisions of T. 20 N., R. 47 E.

Chains

the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high W. of corner.

From which

A Pinon Pine, 9 ins. diam., bears N.44°15'E. 10 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S6BT

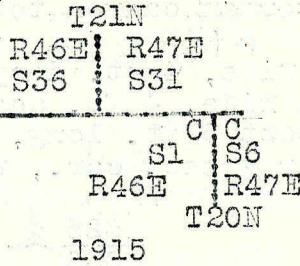
A Pinon Pine 10 ins. diam., bears N.66°40'W., 32 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S1BT

Descend gradual N. slope thru timber.

48.19 N. end of spur, projects N., descend N. slope thru timber land more rolling.

79.80 Intersect 4th Standard Parallel N., 35.56 chs. W. of the Standard Corner of Tp. 21 N., Rs. 46 and 47 E., heretofore described. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of Tp. 20 N., Rs. 46 and 47 E with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high S. of corner.

From which

A Pinon pine 7 ins. in diam., bears S.13°45'W., 75 lks. dist., mkd. T20NR46ES1BT

A Pinon Pine 7 ins. diam., bears S.19°E. 105 lks. dist., mkd. T20NR47ES6BT

Land, mountainous N. slope.

Soil, rich dark loose loam, very rocky with loose and imbedded granite rocks.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, service berry, good growth grass.

Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mountain mahogany.

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 20 N., R. 47 EAST

Surveyed by H.W.Reppert.

Aug. 2, 1915: At 8h.05m., a.m., l.m.t., I set off 39°33' N. on the lat. arc; 17° 57 1/2' N. on the decl. arc; determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

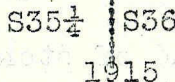
Thence I run

N.0° 01'W. bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over valley land, drains S.E. gradually ascend.

35.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course S.50°E.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high W. of corner.

68.90 Wash, course S. 40°E.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd:
