

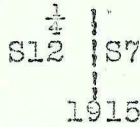

East Boundary T. 21 N., R. 48 East.

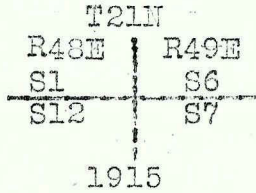
Chains

Land, gently rolling valley.  
Soil, deep sandy loam with small quantities of pebbles.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush, some bunch grass and rabbit brush along draws.  
No timber.

40.00 N. bet. secs. 7 and 12.  
Over gently rolling valley land.  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.;



30.00 dig pits, 18x18x12ins N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of corner.  
Descend gradual slope.  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.;



dig pits, 18x18x12ins, in each sec.  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of cor. Land, gently rolling valley, drains E.  
Soil, light sandy and gravelly brown clay loam, 6 ins. deep on compact clay subsoil.  
Undergrowth, small sagebrush, some bunch grass, rabbit brush along bottom of draws.  
No timber.

10.00 N. on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 6  
Over gently rolling valley land, drains E.  
40.00 Dry wash, course S.  $45^\circ E$ .  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.;



61.30 dig pits, 18x18x12ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of corner.  
81.20 Road from Austin to Tonkin and Pine Valley, bears  $N.20^\circ E$  and  $S.20^\circ W$ .  
The cor. of Tps. 21 and 22 N., Rs. 48 and 49 E., corner previously described. I build a new corner alongside the old cor. as follows:-  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of Tps. 21 and 22, N., Rs. 48 and 49 E., with brass cap mkd.;
