## Subdivisions of T. 21 N., R. 48 E.

Chains

- dig pits, 18x18x12ins. E. and W. of post 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high N. of corner.  
 Corner on top of flat ridge, bears N.  $10^{\circ}W.$  and S.  $10^{\circ}E.$ ; descend gradual slope to the Tp. cor.  
 Road from Ferguson to Pierettis, Tonkin and Eureka, bears N.  $25^{\circ}E.$  and S.  $25^{\circ}W.$   
 The cor. of Tps. 21 and 22 N., Rs. 48 and 49 E., heretofore described.  
 Land, rolling S. slope from mountain.  
 Deep loose sandy and gravelly brownish clay loam soil, about 8 ins. deep, compact clay subsoil.  
 Undergrowth, sagebrush, bunch grass, greasewood, some cactus and heavy growth rabbit brush along draws.

Oct. 4, 1915: At 9h.00m., a.m., l.m.t., I set off  $39^{\circ} 38\frac{1}{2}'$  N. on the lat. arc;  $4^{\circ} 5' S.$  on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the Standard Corner of secs. 35 and 36 on the S. bdy.

Thence I run

N.  $0^{\circ} 01'W.$  bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over level valley land.

5.63 Dry wash, course S.  $70^{\circ}E.$ 7.20 Ascend bank 4 ft. to sage plain, bears N.  $70^{\circ}W.$  and S.  $70^{\circ}E.$ 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.;S35  $\frac{1}{2}$  S36

70.00 Top of raise, bears N.  $70^{\circ}W.$  and S.  $70^{\circ}E.$ , over gently rolling valley land.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.;

dig pits, 18x18x12ins, in each sec.  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of cor.

Land, level and gently rolling valley drains E.

Soil, loose light clay loam, 8 ins. deep, dry and medium texture, subsoil, gravelly loose clay.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbit brush, shadscale and some grass.

No timber.

40.00 Intersect E. bdy. of the Tp. at the cor. of secs. 25, 30,
