

Dig pits, 18x18x12ins. in each sec. 5½ ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.  
 Land, gently rolling with general drainage to the SW.  
 Soil, sandy gravelly clay loam of medium texture, 26 ins. deep.  
 No timber; medium undergrowth of sage brush, greasewood and grass; good grazing, 80 chs.  
 August 6: At this cor. I set off 16° 52' N., on the decl. arc; and at 12h 06m p.m., l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting latitude is 38° 20' N.

40.00 South, on resurvey bet. secs. 31 and 36.  
 Over gently rolling land through medium undergrowth of sage brush, greasewood and scattering grass.  
 By proportional measurement.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



80.00 Dig pits, 18x18x12ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth, 3½ ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of cor.  
 Intersect the standard cor. of Tp. 6 N., Rs. 66 and 67 E., heretofore described.  
 Land, gently rolling with general drainage to the W.  
 Soil, sandy gravelly clay loam of medium texture, 26 ins. deep.  
 No timber; medium undergrowth of sage brush, greasewood and scattering grass; good grazing, 80 chs.  
 August 6, 1915.

EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 6 N., R. 67 EAST

12.00 August 7, 1915: At 7h 06m a.m., l.m.t., I set off 38° 19' N., on the lat. arc; 16° 39' N., on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the standard cor. of Tps. 6 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E., heretofore described.  
 Thence I run  
 North bet. secs. 31 and 36.  
 Over rolling land through scattering growth of cedars and pinon pine and medium undergrowth of sage brush and scattering bunch grass.  
 Ascend gently.  
 17.70 Top of gentle ascent, bears E. and W.  
 Descend.  
 Bottom of descent, bears E. and W.  
 Thence N. on a nearly level line  
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and erect a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, around post for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
