

2. Retracement and resurvey of portions of Subs. of T.20N., R.24 E.

Chains

2 grooves on the E. and 5 grooves on the S. edge. This corner has been remonumented by the U. S. Reclamation Service with an 2 in. iron post showing 12ins. above the ground and having a brass cap mkd.

The course of this mile is S. 0° 26'E. and the length is 80.57 chs.

May 4, 1916: At 8h. 00m., a.m., l.m.t., I set off 39° 38' N. on the lat. arc; 16° 01' N. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 2 and 3 on the N. bdy. of the Tp. heretofore described. Thence I run S. 0° 26'E. on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 3, the course and distance of this mile by previous retracement. The proportionate distance for the reestablished ¼ cor. of secs. 2 and 3. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

dig pits, 18x18x12ins, N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 3½ ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of corner.

The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, heretofore described.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, I run West on retracement between secs. 3 and 10. Intersect the N. and S. line at a point 37 lks. S. of the old ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 10, which is a granite stone, 6x12x8 ins. above ground, firmly set and marked ¼ on the N. side, witnessed by pits and mound of earth. This corner has been remonumented by the U. S. Reclamation service by a 1 in. iron post 3 ft. long showing 10 ins. above ground alongside the old cor. and marked

This ½ mile bears N. 89° 28'W. and its true length is 40.14 chs.

I continue my retracement W. along same line. Intersect the N. and S. line at a point 43 lks. N. of the closing corner of secs. 3 and 10 set from without the Reservation which is a basalt stone, 10x7x10 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked P. L. I. R. on the W. side and C C on the E., witnessed by pits and mound of earth. From this closing corner the closing corner of secs. 3 and 10, set from within the Reservation which is a granite stone, 8x6x12ins. marked P L. I R, and C C lying alongside a 1 in. iron post showing 10 ins. above the ground and marked thus:
