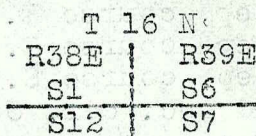

Resurvey of E. Boundary of T. 16 N., R. 38 E.

Chains

From which  
 A Pinon Pine, 10 ins. in dia. bears N.  $35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 36 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S7 BT  
 A Pinon Pine, 18 ins. in dia., bears N.  $49^{\circ}$  W., 59 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S12BT  
 Gradually ascend along SE. slope, 305 ft.  
 60.20 Head of ravine, course SE for 7 chs. thence nearly S.; thence ascend nearly S. slope.  
 74.00 High rocky ridge, 1050 ft. above sec. cor., bears S.  $80^{\circ}$  E. and W., thence along rocky E. face.  
 75.70 Depression, 20 ft. below ridge, drains E.  
 79.30 Rocky point of E. edge of ridge.  
 80.19 Point for restored sec. cor.; on rocky E. slope. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in a mound of stone, with 6 feet base, around post, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.,

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of corner.

Trees too scrubby to mark for bearing trees.

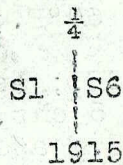
Red rock, prevents post from being set in ground.

Land, mountainous, exposure and drainage to E. and SE.

Soil, rocky and gravelly, mixed with some clay and rich mountain loams, 2nd to 4th rates.

Timber, medium dense pinon and cedars, with a few mahogany near N. end; undergrowth, black sage brush and scattering grass. Grazing land.

N.  $0^{\circ} 10' W.$ , resurveying bet. secs. 1 and 6.  
 Over high, rough mountainous land, through medium dense pinon pine, cedar and mahogany timber.  
 1.70 Top of rocky point on main high ridge, bears S.  $10^{\circ}$ E. and descends N.  $10^{\circ}$ E., descend rocky NW. slope, 75 ft.  
 5.80 Head of canyon, course SW.; saddle of ridge, bears E. 1 ch.  
 Ascend nearly S. slope, 150 ft. to  
 21.00 Ridge, bears N.  $80^{\circ}$ W. and S.  $80^{\circ}$ E., heavy mahogany along this ridge; descend NE. slope, 110 ft.  
 25.00 Head of ravine, course S.  $85^{\circ}$ E.; ascend over broken ledges, facing to the E. 10 ft. to  
 34.70 E. end of high rocky point, bears W. approximately 8 chs to summit of a peak; descend NE. slope, 170 ft. to  
 40.09 Point for restored  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. at head of draw, course E. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



From which  
 A Pinon Pine, 10 ins. in dia. bears S.  $20^{\circ}$ E., 85 lks. dist. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S6BT  
 A Mahogany, 8 ins. in dia. bears S.  $44\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 16 lks. dist. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S1BT  
 Along nearly E. slope.  
 50.50 Ravine, 15 ft. deep, course S.  $80^{\circ}$ E.
