Land, high mountains, general drainage to the S.  
 Soil, rocky and gravelly; limestone formation; mixed  
 with dark, rich mountain loam; 4th to 2nd rates.  
 Timber, scattering pinon pine, mahogany and cedars on  
 mile.  
 Undergrowth, heavy sage brush and scattering grass.  
 Grazing land.

N. 89° 54' E. bet. secs. 1 and 36.  
 Over high mountainous land, through heavy sage brush  
 and scattering grass.  
 3.00 Head of draw, 15 ft. below cor., course NW.; ascend  
 145 ft.  
 9.80 Low spur, projects N. 10° W.; descend NE. slope, 60 ft.  
 16.30 Canyon, 1 ch. wide, course NW.; ascend steep W. slope.  
 31.80 Enter scattering pinon pine and mahogany bears N. and  
 extends S. 7 chs.  
 Thence over SW. slope.  
 40.00 On SW. slope, near S. edge of timber, 475 ft. above  
 canyon.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in  
 the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

 A Cedar 10 ins. in dia., bears S. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 233 lks. dist.  
 mkd.,  $\frac{1}{4}$  S1BT

 Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high N. of  
 corner.  
 Continue ascent over SW. slope.  
 50.00 High main ridge, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.  
 Descend E. slope.  
 57.00 Leave timber, bears NW. and S.  
 67.75 Head of canyon, course NE.; thence descend along nearly  
 N. slope.  
 79.33 On NE. slope, 700 ft. below ridge.  
 The restored cor. of Ts. 16 and 17 N., Rs. 38 and 39 E.  
 Land, high mountains, exposure to N. and SW. on W. 50  
 chs. and to NE. on remainder; drainage to NW. and NE.  
 Soil, gravelly and rocky, mixed with some dark, rich  
 mountain loam; 4th to 2nd rate.  
 Timber, scattering pinon pine, mahogany and few cedars  
 on 25.20 chs.  
 Undergrowth, heavy sage brush and scattering grass.  
 Good grazing land.

SUBDIVISION OF T. 16 N., R. 38 EAST

Nov. 27: At 8h 47m a.m., l.m.t., I set off 39° 16' on  
 the lat. arc; 20° 59' S. on the decl. arc; and determine  
 a meridian at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on N.  
 bdy. of Tp., heretofore described.  
 Thence S. 0° 1' W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.  
 Ascending over mountainous land, facing NE., through  
 heavy sage brush.  
 9.80 Top of high ridge, and divide of mountains, 160 ft.  
 above cor. bears NW. and SE., approximately 20 chs. to  
 high peak.  
 Descend along SW. slope 245 ft.
