


Chains

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for C.C. of Tps. 5 N., Rs. 56 and 57 E. with brass cap marked



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and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, rolling with a general drainage to the W.; soil, light brown gravelly clay loam of hard texture, mixed with some loose lime rock, 26 ins. deep; coarse brown and white gravel and scattering loose lime rock on surface; no timber; scattering undergrowth of shadscale, sage brush, greasewood and grass; scant grazing on the mile.

Subdivision of T.5 N., R.56 E.

From the cor. of secs. 1,2,35 and 36, on S. bdy. of the Tp., heretofore described.

N.0° 01'W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through medium growth of cedars and pinon pine and scattering undergrowth of sage brush, shadscale, juniper, buck brush and grass.

Descend.

2.10 Bottom of hollow, 1 ch. wide, 40 ft. deep, drains NW.

Ascend.

12.50 Top of spur, 110 ft. above hollow, projects NW.

Descend.

22.50 Dry wash, 50 lks. wide, 20 ft. deep, drains N.60°W.

Continue descent.

35.00 Base of steep descent, 240 ft. below top of spur, bears NE. and SW.

Leave mountainous land; enter rolling land, bears NE.
