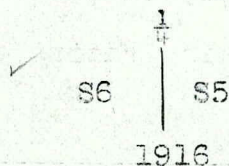
Chains

soil, light brown alluvial sandy clay loam of light texture, mixed with some white alkali, 26 ins. deep; no timber; medium undergrowth of shadscale, greasewood and scattering sage brush and grass; fair grazing.

N.0° 03'W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth of shadscale, greasewood and scattering sage brush and grass.

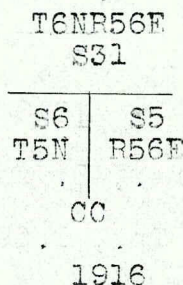
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

81.85 Intersect the First Standard Parallel North, 6.05 chs. N.89° 45'W., of the standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, heretofore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for C.C. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap marked



Dig pite, 24x18x12 ins. crosswise on each line, E. and W., 3 ft., and S. of post, 7 ft. dist.

Land, gently rolling; slight general drainage to the W.; soil, brown sandy clay loam, pliable and damp, mixed with some white alkali, 26 ins. deep; no timber; medium undergrowth of shadscale, greasewood and scattering sage brush and grass, with fair grazing on the mile.
