

Resurvey of East Boundary of T. 47 N., R. 30 E.

Land, rolling valley, drainage W. Soil- gravelly and stony brown clay loam, texture medium, 10 ins. deep, compact clay subsoil, some loose and imbedded rocks on surface. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, scant growth bunch grass. No timber.

From the cor. of secs. 1 and 12,

N. $2^{\circ} 05'$ E. on a true line along E. bdy. of sec. 1

Over gently rolling valley land, draining westward.

26.79 The old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, heretofore described, and hereafter referring to secs. 6 and 7 only. I remark the cor. as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 6 and 7 of T. 47 N., R. 31 E., with brass cap mkd.
