

Metes and Bounds Surveys in T. 47 N., R. 30 E.

Chains claimants, an adoption of a common boundary of lot 4, sec. 4, and lot 1 sec. 5, on which to base the survey of contiguous claims by metes and bounds, as follows: The NW. cor. of lot 4 sec. 4 (embraced in tract survey No. 38), identical with the NE. cor. lot 1 sec. 5 (embraced in tract survey No. 40), will be located at a point and monumented with a 1 in. iron survey post, 30 lks. distant, N. $87^{\circ} 35'$ E. of a post, heretofore described, generally known and supposed to be the reestablished 235 mile 34 chain point on the Oregon-Nevada state boundary, and which bears S. $87^{\circ} 35'$ W., 34.46 chs. distant from the reestablished and recognized 235 mile post on the Oregon-Nevada state boundary, heretofore described. The common boundary between lot 4 sec. 4 (embraced in tract survey No. 38), and lot 1 of sec. 5 (embraced in tract survey No. 40), will extend due south from the above defined and established point, which is a common cor. of these claims, a distance as per the record of the old field notes. The survey of all contiguous tracts are to be based upon and initiated from this common boundary, herewith agreed upon, and in conformity with descriptions and areas of the holdings of the claimants as shown on the official plat of T. 47 N., R. 30 E., approved by the Surveyor General of Nevada, January 12, 1876.

At a point 105.91 chs. N. $88^{\circ} 36'$ E. of the 235 mile post on the Oregon-Nevada state boundary, and which has an easting of 140.00 chs. from the above mentioned common boundary of tracts No. 38 and 40, I establish cor. No. 1 of tract No. 37 as follows:
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for cor. No. 1 tract No. 37, with brass cap mkd.
