
Chains From the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

 Over rolling E. slope asc. gradual slope.

9.00 Gully, 30 ft. below sec. cor., course S. 80° E.; ascend
 over east slope.

17.55 Gulch, course E.; ascend S. slope.

34.85 Top of ridge, 140 ft. above gully, bears N. 70° E. and
 S. 70° W.; descend 100 ft. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the

 cap mkd.


