

## Independent Resurvey of Subdivisions of T. 47 N., R. 30 E.

Chains

Land, gently rolling valley with numerous low sandy hummocks, 6 to 10 ft. high, drainage to the N.  
Soil, sandy light loam, numerous shifting sand banks.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, rabbit brush.  
No timber.

N. 0° 03' E. bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over gently rolling valley land and plain with sandy hummocks.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd.

dig pits, 18 X 18 X 12 ins., N. and S. of cor., 3 ft. dist.

No traces of the old cor. found after diligent search.

57.40 Road from Denio to Wyley creek, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.

112.24 Intersect Oregon-Nevada state boundary 161.034 chs. N. 88° 36' E., from Cor. No. 1 Tract No. 37, heretofore described. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd.

dig pits, 24 X 18 X 12 ins., crosswise on each line, E. and W., 3 ft., and S. of cor. 7 ft. dist.

No traces of the old closing cor. found.

Land, valley crossing over numerous low sandy hummocks and shifting sand dunes.

Undergrowth, scant growth sagebrush and greasewood.

Soil, deep sandy loam, shifting sand dunes.

No timber.
