

South Boundary of T. 47 N., R. 57 E.

80.77 Fall 13 lks. N. of the 76 Mile cor. which is a lava stone 24x18x6 ins. in a mound of stone 2 1/2 ft. base, 2 ft. high, and marked I. 42 L on N. face and N. 76 M. on S. face. Therefore the course of this line is N. 89° 54' W.

Beginning at the 76 Mile cor.

I retrace th.
East on the 76 mile.

81.51 Fall 30 lks. N. of the 75 Mile cor. which is a lava stone 25x25x5 ins., marked N. on the S. face, 75 M. on the E. face; also a lava stone 24x10x3 ins., marked I. on the N. face and 42 L. on the west face. These stones are in a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high. Therefore the course of this line is N. 89° 47' W.

80.77 Fall 16 lks. N. of the 74 Mile cor. which is a lava stone 24x16x3 ins., in a mound of stone 2 1/2 ft. base, 2 ft. high, and marked I. 42 L. on N. face and N. 74 M. on S. face. Therefore the course of this line is N. 89° 53' W.

From the 74 Mile cor.

I retrace th.
East on the 74 mile.

80.67 Fall 5 lks. N. of the 73 Mile cor. which is a lava stone 30x16x4 ins. in a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 1/2 ft. high, and marked I. 42 L. on N. face and N. 73 M. on S. face. Therefore the course of the line is N. 89° 58' W.

South Boundary of T. 47 N., R. 57 E.

From the cor. of Tps. 46 and 47 N., Rs. 56 and 57 E., heretofore described,

East between secs. 6 and 31.

Over mountainous land; asc gradually along N. side of draw course W. Through dense short undergrowth.

39.35 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 26 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

79.35 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, with brass cap mkd:
