South Boundary of T. 47 N., R. 58 E.

Chs.

- 50.00 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; desc. gradually.
- 76.20 Dry creek in the bottom of draw, 35 ft. below top of spur, course NW.; asc. W. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd:

- 21.10 Bottom of draw, 30 ft. below top of spur, course N.20°W.; asc. W. slope.
- 32.30 Top of spur, 45 ft. above bottom of draw, projects N.20°W.; desc. NE. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
