Land; rolling, E. 25 chs., rolling mountainous W. 30 chs., remainder of mile, steep and rough.

Soil; rocky, dark clay, gravelly on surface, from a few ins. to 2 ft. deep, to a light clay subsoil or bed rock.

Timber; heavy aspen and mahogany along Dave Creek.

Undergrowth; dense short sagebrush and yellow top, young aspen along Dave Creek.


E. and W. exposure. Drainage N.

Good growth of grass. Volcanic formation.

N.0°01'W. on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Over rolling mountainous land, through dense short sagebrush and yellow top; desc. gradual NE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

This cor. is 110 ft. below sec. cor.

44.80 Bottom of hollow, 15 ft. below 1/4 sec. cor., course NW.; asc.

65.90 Top of ridge, 85 ft. above bottom of hollow, bears N.20°W. and S.20°E.; desc. gradually.

69.12 Intersect the Nevada Idaho State Bdy. line, 12.85 chs. S.89°51'E. of the 69 mile cor., hereinbefore described, and at the point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 22 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd:
