

Retracement of S. bdy. of T 24 N, R 18 E.

Chains

chs. S. of line.

This corner is a granite stone 12 x 8 x 6 ins., set 8 ins. in the ground, marked with 1 notch on the W. and 5 notches on the E. edge.

Course of this mile is S 88°57'W. Length 79.68 chs.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.

Retrace W. bet. secs. 6 and 31.

7.24 The old closing corner of Tps. 23 and 24 N, R 18 E, on the state line bet. Nevada and California, falls 7 lks. N. of line.

This cor. is an old juniper stake, 1 in. dia., by 2 ft. long, lying on the ground on an old mound of earth, it is so badly decayed that the markings can not be deciphered.

39.95 The old  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor., falling 42 lks. N. of line.

This cor. is a granite stone 8 x 6 ins. by 7 ins. above ground, marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  on the N. face.

Course of this  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile is N 89°24'W

Retracement of State Line bet. Nevada and California.

Begin at Mile Post No. 145, which is a cut stone monument, firmly set in the ground, of the dimensions, marked, and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General. The top of the monument has been broken off and is lying on the ground alongside of the monument.

Thence N., retracing on the State Line.

5.69 The old closing corner of Tps. 23 and 24 N, R 18 E, previously described, falls 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  lks. E. of line.

80.00 Search diligently, but find no monument for Mile Post No. 144

Continue retracing N. on the same line.

159.60 Mile Post No. 143, falling 1.52 chs. E. of line.

This cor. is a pine post 6 x 6 ins. by 3 ft. above ground
