1.60	Desc. W. slope of wide spur.
6.83	Ravine, course N 10°W, 60 ft. below spur. Asc. N.E. slope.
8.32	30 ft. above ravine.
	Intersect the State line at: N 0°33'E, 9.26 chs. from Mile Post No. 143.
	Set a volcanic stone 22 x 10 x 8 ins., 15 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 19 and 30, mkd. with 2 notches on the S. and 4 notches on the N. edge and 5 notches on the E. edge.
	Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high E. of cor.
	Land, high, rolling mountains of granite and volcanic rock. with a slope to the N.W.
	Soil, dry, gravelly and rocky. 3rd. and 4th. rate. Fair feed of sagebrush, with some grass and weeds. A few scattering juniper trees.
