Land, high, rolling mountains of granite, with a general
N.W. and northerly slope.

Soil, dry, coarse texture, sandy and gravelly. 3rd. and
4th. rate. Some outcrops of granite ledges. Fair feed of
sagebrush, with some grass, weeds and other browse. No
timber.

N 0°4' E, east of sec. 1.

Over rolling granite mountains with a general northerly
slope. Desc. N.W. slope.

18.48 Head of large draw, course S 65°W. 125 ft. below sec. cor.
Asc. S.W. slope.

31.95 Low spur, slopes N.W., 55 ft. above draw. Desc. N.W.
slope.

29.48 75 ft. below spur.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins in the
ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 1, with brass cap mkd.

73.20 Low saddle between hills, bears N.E. and S.W., 65 ft. above
draw. Desc. N.W. slope.

78.96 20 ft. below saddle

The cor. of Tps. 23 and 24 N, Rgs. 18 and 19 E, which
I reestablish as follows:

At the same point, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins.
dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of Tps. 23 and 24 N,
Rgs. 18 and 19 E, with brass cap mkd.
