

## Resurvey of N. bdy. of T 23 N, R 19 E.

Chains

- 52.40 Spur, slopes S 30°W, 190 ft. above ravine. Thence along steep S. slope.
- 55.50 Draw, course S.W., asc. steep S.W. slope. Leave scattering juniper trees, bear N.E. and S.W.
- 66.10 Large rocky spur, slopes S 10°W, 310 ft. above draw. Desc. rocky S.E. slope.
- 78.70 Large ravine, course S 50°W, 215 ft. below spur. Asc. N.W. slope.
- 80.00 15 ft. above ravine.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

Land, W. 15.00 chs. is rolling land, E. 65.00 chs. is high, granite mountains, with a general S. slope.

Soil, dry, somewhat gravelly, sandy. Some outcrops of granite ledges. 3rd. and 4th. rate. Fair feed of sagebrush, with some grass and weeds. Scattering juniper trees on the W. 55.50 chs.

S 89°43'E, south of sec. 36.

Over high granite mountains. Asc. rocky N.W. slope.

- 19.50 Rocky spur, slopes S., 375 ft. above sec. cor. Desc. S.E. slope.

32.40 Ravine, course S 20°W, 60 ft. below spur. Asc. S.W. slope.

38.00 Spur, slopes S., 85 ft. above ravine. Desc. S.E. slope.

40.00 45 ft. below spur, in small ravine, course S.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia. 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
