Chains

3rd. and 4th. rate. Fair feed of sagebrush, with some weeds and grass. Scattering juniper trees.

N 0°1'W bet. secs. 1 and 2

Asc. S.W. slope of high, granite mountains, through scattering juniper trees.

13.60 Spur, slopes S.W., 225 ft. above sec. cor.

20.00 Head of draw, course S.W. Asc. S.W. slope.

40.00 220 ft. above draw.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

67.45 Point of spur, slopes W., 25 ft. above ravine. Thence

along W. slope.

72.70 Large ravine, course S. 60°W. Asc. steep S.W. slope.

73.82 Intersect the N. bdy. of the tp. at N 89°43'W, 2.95 chs.

from the cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd.
