S. bdy. of T 17 N, R 35 E.

Soil, dry, gravelly and rocky, 3rd. rate. Unfit for cultivation. Rather poor feed of sagebrush and sñadscale, with some grass and weeds. No timber.

W. bet. secs. 6 and 31

Over rolling land, with a general northerly slope.

- 5.00 Low spur, slopes N 35°<sub>w</sub>W, 20 ft. above sec. cor. Desc. gradual W. slope.
- 10.00 Small draw, course N.W., 15 ft. below spur. Asc. gradually.
- 11.00 Low spur, slopes N.W., 10 ft. above draw. Desc. gradually.
- 16.45 Small draw, course N.W., 15 ft. below spur. Asc. gradually.
- 19.00 Low spur, slopes N 30°W, 20 ft. above draw. Desc. gradually.
- 21.10 Large draw, course N 25°W, 10 ft. below spur. Asc. gradually.
- 23.15 Low spur, slopes N.W., 15 ft. above draw. Desc. gradually.
- 29.90 Large draw, course N 55°W, 15 ft. below spur. Asc. N.E. slope.
- 33.00 Low spur, slopes N 30°W, 15 ft. above draw. Desc. westerly slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.
