10.73 Lincoln Highway, bears N 70° E and S 70° W

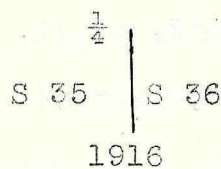
20.86 Large wash, course W.

21.35 Wire fence bears, S 65° W and N 65° E.

24.15 Small wash, course S. W.

39.50 Wire fence, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.



dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

A cabin bears S 84° 50' E, 57.50 chs. dist.

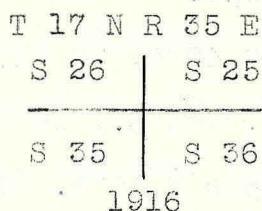
53.00 Wash, course S 75° W.
