Chains

ridges and steep slopes with exposed volcanic ledges of rock. Undergrowth, sagebrush, deer browse and bunch grass. Timber juniper on E. 30.90 chs. and W. 20.00 chs.

West, on a true line on S. Bdy. of secs. 32.

Over heavy rolling land, descend, descend gradual slope, scattered timber.

5.00 Foot of descent and depressions, 30 ft. below standard sec. cor., drains S. 20° W.; asc. gradual S. and SE. slope.

15.00 Top of ascent on gradual S. slope, 10 ft. above bottom of depression; desc. gradual W. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., for sec. 32, with brass cap mkd.

62.00 Top of steep ascent, bears N. and S. 140 ft. above bottom of ravine; asc. gradual slope 120 ft. to the closing cor.

79.70 Intersect the Cal.-Nev. State Bdy. line, at a point, 13.45 chs. S. 0° 11' E. of the 72nd Mile post, heretofore described. At the point of intersection, Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., on solid ledge of rock and in a mound of stone, 6 ft. base, for the standard closing cor. of T. 36 N., R. 18 E. with brass cap mkd.
