Chains

N. 89° 21' W., on a true line on the S. Bdy. of sec. 35.
Over level land, through dense undergrowth. Along wire
fence and road paralleling line.

34.64 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 2, with brass cap mkd.

80.61 Intersect the old cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, which is
a cottonwood post, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. sq., 2 ft. long, broken off
with markings nearly obliterated, lying alongside of
traces of old mound of earth, with a pine stake 6 ft.
long, in the center. This cor. is identical with cor.
No. 3 of Tract No. 49 and cor. No. 1 of Tract No. 51.
As this cor. is in poor condition, I reestablish this
cor. in its original position as follows:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground, for cor. of secs. 34 and 35, and cor. No. 3 of
Tract No. 49 and cor. No. 1 of Tract No. 51, with brass
cap mkd.
