

## 76. Independent Resurvey of Subdivisions of T. 36 N., R. 18 E.

- Chains
- From the reestablished standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. boundary of the Township heretofore described. N.  $0^{\circ} 01'$  W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.
- Over bench land, through scattered timber.
- 13.20 Descend from bench, edge bears N.  $60^{\circ}$  W., and S.  $60^{\circ}$  E.
- 31.13 Base of steep descent, 240 ft. below top of bench; desc. gradual N. slope 45 ft. to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., on solid surface rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

- A juniper tree, 7 ins. diam., bears S.  $40^{\circ}$  E., 55 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 B T.
- A juniper tree, 12 ins. diam., bears N.  $73^{\circ} 30'$  W., 253 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. 35 B T.
- No traces of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. found, after diligent search.
- Descend along rolling N. and NW. slope, leave
- 56.25 Wood road, bears N.  $30^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $30^{\circ}$  W.
- 63.63 Ravine, 6 lks. wide, 110 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., course N.  $20^{\circ}$  E.; descend along W. edge of ravine 120 ft. to the sec. cor.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.

- A juniper tree, 8 ins. diam., bears S.  $12^{\circ} 40'$  E., 258 lks. dist., mkd. T 36 N R 18 E S 36 B T.
- A juniper tree, 10 ins. diam., bears S.  $34^{\circ} 45'$  W., 160
