

Chains and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, E. of cor.

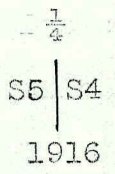
Land, rolling, drainage SW. Soil, stony and gravelly clay loam in foothills, valley land has a deep dark brown clay soil, generally free from rock. Undergrowth, sagebrush, bunch grass. No timber.

N. 0° 03' W. on a true line bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Over rolling land ascend gradual slope

15.00 Gulch, course S. 20° W.; ascend gradually. N. 25° E.  
16.30 Road from Surprise to Tuledad Valley, bears S. 25° W. and  
40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the

ground for the 1/2 cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd.



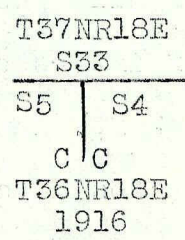

61.00 Top of rounding ridge, 160 ft. above gulch, bears E. and W.; descend N. slope.

64.40 Gulch, 20 ft. below top of ridge, course N. 80° E.; ascend rolling E. and SE. slope 70 ft. to the closing cor.

101.23 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., at a point 5.84 chs. E. of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 of T. 37 N., R. 18 E., heretofore described. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd.
