The portion of the township included in this survey, is gently rolling land, sloping westward and having a general drainage in the same direction. The soil is a deep rich alluvial loam, stony and rocky along the south boundary of secs. 31 and 32. The balance of the land is generally free from rock.

A portion of the ranch of Jim Beebe, which consists of wild meadow pasture and hay land is located in both secs. 31 and 32 out side the reservation boundary.
