 Land, rolling; general drainage, southwesterly; soil,  
 light brown sandy gravelly loam of medium texture, 26  
 ins. deep; no timber; medium undergrowth of sage brush  
 and scattering greasewood and grass; fair grazing, 80  
 chs.

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S.89° 59'E., bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth of sage  
 brush and scattering greasewood and grass.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in  
 the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

 no timber; medium undergrowth of sage brush and scatter-  
 ing greasewood and grass; fair grazing, 80 chs.

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Subdivision of T.12 N., R.50 E.

From the cor. of secs. 13,14,23 and 24, herein and after  
 described, I survey

N.0° 01'W., bet. secs. 13 and 14.

Over rough mountainous land, through medium growth of  
 cedars and pinon pine and scattering undergrowth of  
 sage brush, greasewood and grass.

Descend steeply.

2.00 Creek, 2 lks. wide, 1 inch deep, in bottom of canyon, 70  
 ft. below sec. cor., drains W.

Ascend steeply.
