

## Subdivision of T.12 N., R.50 E.

## Chains

medium undergrowth of sage brush and scattering grass and greasewood; fair grazing, 80 chs.

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East, bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Over rolling hilly land, through medium growth of cedars and pinon pine and medium undergrowth of sage brush and scattering greasewood and grass.

East from sec. cor., on a near level line.

23.40 Dry wash,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  chs. wide, 20 ft. deep, drains NW.

40.00 Set a granite stone, 7x8x17 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face; no suitable bearing trees available; raise a mound of stone,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

Cor. stands at point of ascent over rough mountainous land, bears N. and S.

53.00 Top of rocky spur, 220 ft. above  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. and point of ascent, projects NW., about 3 chs.

Descend gradually along south side of ravine.

Enter dense growth of timber, bears N. and S.

60.15 Bottom of descent, 40 ft. below top of spur, bears N. and S.

Ascend steeply.

80.00 Set a granite stone, 10x10x12 ins., 6 ins. in mound of stone, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, marked with 1 notch on N., and 5 notches on S. face; no suitable bearing trees available; raise a mound of stone,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.

Cor. stands on steep W. slope of ridge, 460 ft. above point of steep ascent.

Land, rolling hills on W. 40 chs.; rough and mountainous on E. 40 chs.; general exposure and drainage of the mile is to the NW.; soil, stony on surface, of granite formation; 4th rate; medium growth of cedars and pinon pine on W. 53 chs.; dense growth of same on E. 27 chs.; medium undergrowth of sage brush and scattering greasewood and grass; scant grazing.
