Chains

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor. Find no evidence of the old 1/2 sec. cor.

46.30 Ravine, course N. 60° E.

65.30 Ravine, course NE.

82.70 Road, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.

90.70 Intersect the 8th Standard Parallel North at a point 37.32 chs., E. of the S. C. of T. 41 N., Rs. 21 and 22 E., at which point set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of T. 40 N., Rs. 21 and 22 E., with brass cap marked;

Land rolling, general drainage to the NE.

Soil, heavy rocky clay loam, medium depth, covered with scattering basalt rocks.

Scant growth of sage and bunch grass.

No timber.

Independent Resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T. 40 N., R. 21 E.

From the SE. cor. of T. 40 N., R. 20 E., which is a basalt stone, 21 X 20 X 5 ins., showing 5 ins. above ground, firmly set; marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. I mark 6 notches on the E. edge, making it a cor. for T. 40 N., R. 21 E. also, and move mound of stone to N.

North on true line on the independent resurvey of the W. bdy of sec. 31.

Over rolling land. Desc. N. slope.

9.20 Bottom of draw, 40 ft. below sec. cor., course NE.; asc. SE. slope.
