Scant growth of sage and bunch grass.

No timber.

N.  $0^{\circ} 02'$  W. on true line bet. secs. 3 and 4.Over broken land. Desc. NW. slope very gradually 170 ft.  
to closing cor.

in the ground, in dense thicket of sage, for C. C. of  
secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap marked;

No timber.
