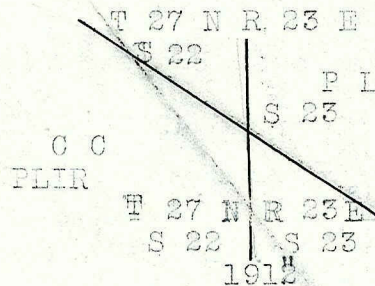


Fractional Subdivision, T 27 N, R 23 E.

Chains

Begin at the closing corner of secs. 22 and 23, on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation bdy. This corner is an iron post, firmly set, of the dimensions, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General. I place additional markings on this post for the fractional T 27 N, R 23 E, lying outside the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation bdy. and it is now mkd. as follows:

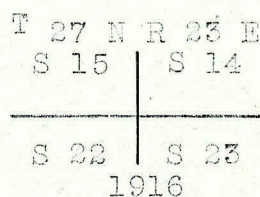


N 0°3'E bet. secs. 22 and 23

Over somewhat rolling land.

6.25 Wash, course S 80°E.

9.82 At this point, which is east of the closing corner of secs. 15 and 22,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, with brass cap mkd.



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high
W. of cor.

Land, somewhat rolling with a slope to the E.

Soil, dry, sandy and gravelly. 2nd. rate. Poor feed of sagebrush, with some grass and weeds. No timber.
