

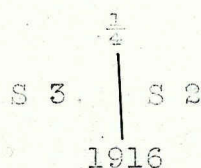
Fractional Subdivision, T 27 N, R 23 E.

Chains

Over somewhat rolling land, with a slope to the S.E.

8.33 Wash, course S 50°E, 45 ft. below sec. cor.

17.52 Road, bears N 75°E and S 75°W.

23.77 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

25.80 Wash, course S 65°E.

35.87 Road, bears S.W. and N.E.

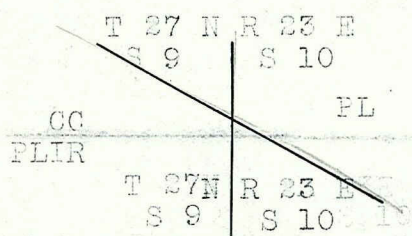
58.87 Wash, course N 75°E

63.77 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Land, somewhat rolling, with a slope to the E.

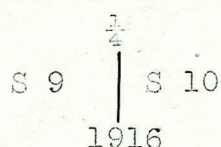
Soil, dry, gravelly and rocky. 3rd. rate. Poor feed of sagebrush, with some grass and weeds. No timber.

Begin at the closing corner of secs. 9 and 10, on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation bdy. This corner is an iron post, firmly set, of the dimensions, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General. I place additional markings on this post for the fractional T 27 N, R 23 E, lying outside the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation bdy. and it is now mkd. as follows:



N 0°2'E, bet. secs. 9 and 10.

Over somewhat rolling land.

1.50 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor. Desc. rolling N. slope.
