Meanders Winnemucca Lake.

Begin at the W.C. on the shore of Winnemucca lake, which W.C. bears S $31^{\circ}55'E$, 24.00 chs. from Mile Post No. 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation bdy. This W.C. is a volcanic stone, firmly set, of the dimensions, mkd., and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

Thence with meanders in sec. 23, along the shore of Winnemucca lake.
