14.00	Gulch, course S.30°E.; asc. 115 ft. to
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., for sec. 11½, with brass cap mkd. T40N S2 S11 R22½E 1919

33.30	Top of cliff; thence over nearly level table land.
