Over rolling mountainous table land, through dense undergrowth and over rocky surface, asc.

4.60 Top of ledge, 60 ft. above cor., bears N. and S.; thence ascend gradually over rocky bench, 130 ft. to

25.90 Top of ledge, 30 ft. high, bears N. and S.; thence over nearly level table land very rocky.
