

Stock Company; and agreed to adjust the boundaries thereof to the lines of the resurvey executed by Emil Voigt in 1919, as per signed statement made a part of and attached to the end of these field notes.

NOTE:

Before the survey of T. 40 N., R. 23 E., was executed in 1919, several settlers located and filed entries in this township, by surveys initiated from the reestablished corners established by W.E.Hoffman, U.S. surveyor, in the independent resurvey of the east two miles of the S. Bdy. T. 40 N., R. 23 E.

The description of their claims do not conflict according to the original plat of this township, but on the ground do conflict with State Land Selections, owing to the fact that the original subdivisions lines are about 1 mile and 20.00 chs. West; and about 20.00 chs. North of the lines initiated from the reestablished corners on the S. Bdy. and thereby causing controversy.

A decision was rendered by the District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada, regarding these controversies in favor of the State Lands Selections.

Not finding any of these settlers living on their respective claims, and not knowing their addresses, while executing the present surveys on the ground of various State Land Selections, and further owing to these irregularities and erroneous locations, still conflicting with present locations, it was impossible to adjust these several settlers claims.

Therefore tracts Nos. 51, 52 and 53 remain unaltered as surveyed in 1919.
