

Dependent Resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North Through
Range 23 East.

Chains
65.50 Rim of West branch of High Rock Creek Canyon, bears N.
10°E. and S.10°W.; precipitous descent of 15 ft.; thence
desc. abruptly over sliderock, 600 ft. to
77.40 Base of abrupt descent; leave sliderock and enter bottom
land, through dense undergrowth, bears N. and S.
80.07 Intersect evident remains of the old standard cor. of secs.
31 and 32; The old cor., which was a granite stone, has
disappeared, but remains of a mound of stone in its
proper place still remains. This cor. being situated on
brink of channel of West branch of High Rock Creek, I
therefore preserve the position of the true point for
standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, as follows: At a
point N. 89° 22'E., 20 lks. distance.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground, for witness cor. to standard cor. of secs. 31
and 32, with brass cap mkd.
