- Chains and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- 40.10 Ravine, 30 ft. below top of spur, course E.; asc.
- 48.50 Top of spur, 90 ft. above ravine, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.; desc.
- 65.60 Head of ravine, 200 ft. below spur, course NE.; asc.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6

- Desc. over mountainous land, through dense sagebrush.
- 6.70 Edge of rimrock, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; thence desc. abruptly over slide rock.
- 16.00 Leave mountainous land and slide rock, enter rolling land, bears NW. and SE.; thence through dense undergrowth.
- 25.00 Road, Soldier Meadows to Massacre, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
- 26.10 Right bank of West Branch of High Rock Creek, 8 ft. high, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
- 26.40 Channel of High Rock Creek, 20 lks. wide, 3 ins. deep, running alkali water, course S. 30° E.
- 27.10 Left bank of West Branch of High Rock Creek, 5 ft. high, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
