

Subdivision of T. 9 S., R. 62 E.

Chains	
68.30	Top of spur, 180 ft. above gulch, projects SW. Descend.
77.40	Gulch, 190 ft. below top of spur, drains S. 40° W. Ascend.
79.90	The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12, 50 ft. above gulch. Land, rolling hills and mountainous. Soil; shallow, very rocky, sandy loam; much rock outcropping. No timber. Undergrowth; scattering greasewood, rabbit brush, yucca, Joshua. Very little grass.
	----- N. 0° 1' W., bet. secs. 1 and 2. ----- Over mountainous land. Ascend along E. slope of ridge.
32.30	Top of ridge, 230 ft. above cor., bears N. 80° E. and S. 10° W. Descend.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked $\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\ S \ 2 \ \ S \ 1 \\ 1917 \end{array}$ and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
43.90	Gulch, 190 ft. below top of ridge, drains W. Ascend abruptly.
64.00	Top of spur, 300 ft. above gulch, projects SW. Descend.
79.60	Head of gulch, 160 ft. below top of spur, drains S. 30° W. Ascend.
81.03	Intersect Second Standard Parallel South and S. bdy. of sec. 35, T. 8 S., R. 62 E., 7.47 chs. W. of S.C. of secs. 35 and 36. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap marked
