Chains

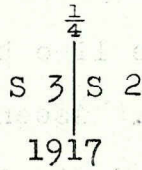

N. 0° 1' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over heavily rolling to hilly land.

28.20 Dry wash, drains SW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock, in mound of stone, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked



and raise mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor. Cor. stands 170 ft. above sec. cor.

Descend.

53.30 Gulch, 120 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., drains SW.

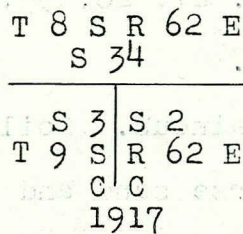
Enter mountainous land, bears NE. and SW. Ascend steep SE. slope.

71.20 Top of ridge, 340 ft. above gulch, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W. Descend.

79.10 Top of almost vertical cliffs, 100 ft. high, bear E. and W. Descend over cliffs.

81.11 Intersect Second Standard Parallel South and S bdy. of sec. 34, T. 8 S., R. 62 E., 7.55 chs. W. of the S.C. of secs 34 and 35.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap marked.



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, S. of cor.

Land; heavily rolling, hilly, and mountainous. Soil; very rocky, gravelly, sandy loam. No timber.
