

EXAMINATION FOR OBLITERATION.

4. Tps. 15 & 16 S., R. 56 E., & T. 16 S., R. 55 E.

Cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 & 24, on E. bdy. of Tp.

A limestone 6x5x5 ins. lying loose on an earth mound plainly marked 3 notches on opposite edges, dim traces of four pits, NE, SE, SW & NW. of cor.

The 1/4 cor. bet. secs. 13 & 18, on E. bdy. of Tp.

A limestone 8x6x5 ins. lying loose on an earth mound, plainly marked 1/4 on one face, plain traces of pits E. and W. of cor.

Cor. of secs. 17, 12, 13 & 18, on E. bdy. of Tp.

A limestone 14x5x4 ins. lying loose on the ground, plainly marked 4 grooves on one face 2 grooves on opposite face, not witness-

The 1/4 cor. bet. secs. 12 & 13.

A limestone 14x7x3 ins. lying loose on the ground, plainly marked 1/4 on one face, not witnessed.

The 1/4 cor. bet. secs. 13 & 14.

A limestone 10x8x5 ins. lying loose on an earth mound, plainly marked 1/4 on one face, not witnessed.

The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 & 29.

A limestone 14x8x4 ins. lying loose on an earth and stone mound, plainly marked 4 grooves on one face and 2 grooves on adjoining faces, plain
