

## EXAMINATION FOR OBLITERATION.

Tps. 15 &amp; 16 S., R. 56 E., &amp; T. 16 S., R. 55 E.

The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 & 30

A limestone 8x5x5 ins. above ground, firmly set in an earth mound, plainly marked 4 notches on N. 2 notches on S. edges, traces of 3 pits, NE, SE and NW of cor.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. bet. secs. 19 & 24.

A quartzite stone 12x6x4 ins. loosely set in a stone mound, plainly marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face, not witnessed.

The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 & 24.

A limestone 16x12x9 ins. firmly set in a mound, plainly marked 3 notches on N. and S. edges, not witnessed.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. bet. secs. 13 & 18.

A quartzite stone 12x12x4 ins. loosely set in a stone mound, plainly marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face and 3 notches on N. & S. edges, not witnessed

The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 & 18.

A quartzite stone 14x10x7 ins. loosely set in a stone mound, plainly marked 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edges, not witnessed.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. bet. secs. 7 & 12.

A limestone 6x6x5 ins. above ground, firmly set in an earth mound, plainly marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, traces of three pits, SE, SW and NW of cor.

The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 & 12.

A limestone 4x2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 1  $\frac{3}{4}$  ins. lying loose on an earth mound, plainly marked (x) on one face, plain traces of 4 pits, NE, SE, SW and NW of mound.

The position for cor. of Tps. 15 & 16 S., Rs. 55 & 56 E. is marked only with a stone mound.

The following is a description of cors. found monumented on part of the "Ruby Valley Guide Meridian" in T. 15 S., bet. Rs. 55 & 56 E., Mt. D. Base & Mer.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. bet. secs. 31 & 36.
